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## **STUDENT ADMISSIONS & REGISTRATION**

**WHO MAY ENROLL IN COURSES AT THE S.S.P.?** —If you are a born again child of God and are at least 18 years old, you may enroll in courses at the School of the Sons of the Prophets. If you are not born again and would like to attend the School, please stop reading and call the church secretary, Sister Ophelia Copperrickel, immediately and without hesitation, for further instructions. You do NOT need to have a high school diploma or a G.E.D. The only documentation required is a letter of recommendation from your pastor and two letters of recommendation from fellow believers who have known you for at least six months. International applicants must, in addition, provide proof of a visa to study abroad and proof of living accommodations. Of course, no proof of visa or living accommodations is required for those who wish to enroll in S.S.P.'s online courses. (Note that not all classes are offered online. Refer to the class schedule.) TOEFL scores and school records are unnecessary.

**HOW DO I ENROLL?** —Admission into the School of the Sons of the Prophets is very easy. Request your pastor and two fellow believers who have known you for at least six months to send us letters of recommendation. Print out and fill out the **APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION** form (visible when you turn this page) and mail it to **SCHOOL OF THE SONS OF THE PROPHETS**.

**MAY I TRANSFER CREDITS?** —Due to the specialized nature of the course offerings at F.C.T.'s S.S.P., no transfer credits are admissible.

**HOW DO I REGISTER FOR CLASSES?** —Once you have sent in your application, you will receive a class schedule and class registration form in the mail. Look over the class schedule and choose which classes you desire to take based on the requirements for the certification you are pursuing, being attentive to the times so as not to doublebook and have a time conflict in your schedule. We are not responsible for mistakes you make due to careless inattention to the details of class times. After you have assured that there is no time conflict between any of the classes you have selected, fill out the registration form, add up the cost of your tuition and fees and mail in your payment with your registration form. Once you have enrolled, only 80% of your tuition and fees may be refunded prior to the start of the first class. Students who drop after the first class will not receive a refund. (Note: We reserve the right to cancel any class due to insufficient enrollment or teacher scheduling issues.)

## TUITION & FINANCIAL AID

HOW MUCH IS TUITION? —Tuition for the School of the Sons of the Prophets is \$222 per credit. Most classes are generally 3 credits each and meet for three hours each week. There are only two textbooks required for our classes: 1) the Authorized Version or King James Version of the Holy Bible and 2) Strong's Exhaustive Concordance of the Holy Bible. Most likely, though, you will also wish to purchase some of the books published through Feema Press which you will find in our book store. Most of these books cost between \$12 and \$16 each, but, to restate, they are not required. We also encourage students to consult the Bible commentaries in the church office, approved for use by Dr. Dinkins and our faculty. These commentaries are only available for use on site and must be checked out to students by the church secretary, Sister Copperrickel.

HOW CAN I RECEIVE FINANCIAL AID? —The School of the Sons of the Prophets is a faith-based work. We encourage all prospective students to begin to believe God for financial increase by sowing their monetary seed into the work of the Lord that they might reap a harvest of financial prosperity and begin to live the abundant life Jesus promised. One way of doing this is by making a faith vow to Faith Confession Tabernacle and fulfilling your vow by making a faith donation via credit card or taking out a loan from your bank or credit union. One of the first things you, as a son of the prophets, must learn is to believe God to supply all of your needs according to his riches in glory. If you act on this in faith believing, you shall receive authority from on high to decree a thing and it shall be established unto you. The riches of heaven are yours if you will become rich in faith by showing your faith by your works in the act of giving to the ministry. Partial tuition-write-offs are also available for students who are willing to donate several hours per week in working for the increase of the Body at FCT. Field experience, required to receive credit for some classes, is available while earning a partial, tuition-write-off. Contact the church secretary, Sister Opelia Copperrickel, for more information. We also recommend that you contact your local pastor and ask financial help as you seek to follow the leading of the Lord in answering his call to

ministry. You can also talk to your financial institution about the possibility of taking out a personal loan to help pay for your training in the School of the Sons of the Prophets. Every year we see people who were without natural means to attend our school and yet the Lord provided above all they could ever ask or imagine.

He is a devout supporter of Temple reconstruction, Hebraic revival, and of the use of Jewish music, dance, and other art forms within worship and zealously seeks to purify the Church of Greek and Latin gentilisms.

## **GRADUATION**

Graduation is a special time when students receive a certificate verifying the experience gained through their labors. The graduation ceremony at the School of the Sons of the Prophets can last several hours or even days and involves the laying on of hands and the transference of anointing from people experienced in the student's particular training certificate through the placement of a sheepskin mantle upon the student's shoulders. The gifts of the Spirit are always in operation like clockwork at graduation and students are commonly slain under the power and given personal prophecies or tongues and interpretation through faculty members or anyone else in attendance who feels led to deliver such a message. Many alumni report that the most memorable highlight of their spiritual experience at S.S.P. occurred at their graduation.

## **THE TEN MOST FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **FAQ 1: Is the School of the Sons of the Prophets an accredited institution?**

The School of the Sons of the Prophets continually seeks the approval of God, rather than the approval of men and, as such, will never seek the accreditation of a man-based accrediting board. The approval of God is evidenced in the signs and wonders wrought at the School.

### **FAQ 2: Can I earn a college degree at the School of the Sons of the Prophets?**

You will not earn a degree to impress people in the world. Rather, what you can gain at the School of the Sons of the Prophets is, first of all, valuable ministerial training and experience and, secondly, a certificate verifying to your pastor or other fellow ministers and brothers in Christ that you have completed a rigorous course of training in the field specified on your certificate.

### **FAQ 3: Why should I delay entering the ministry in order to attend the School?**

While it is true that every minute about 217 more precious souls are swallowed by the jaws of an eternal hell of torment, it is important to be trained before entering the ministry. The precedent was set by the Sons of the Prophets who dwelt together in the wilderness under the spiritual guidance of a Prophet or Prophets in the Old Testament. All men of God go through a time of preparation and training. Moses, Elijah, Elisha, Jesus, and Paul all delayed their ministry and underwent a training period. At the School of the Sons of the Prophets you will receive invaluable, hands-on training in functioning in the overflow so as to avoid the burn out characteristic of those who devote their lives to the ministry. You will learn how to flow in the gifts of the Holy Ghost and will be more effective in the harvest of souls and the kindling of revival in your area of ministry.

**FAQ 4: Will I be able to work miracles by the time I receive my certificate of ministry?**

We guarantee, along with the Word, that miraculous signs will flow the true-blue believer. The School of the Sons of the Prophets makes no claim to the ability to evaluate the genuineness of a person's faith. Therefore the School cannot guarantee that you, personally, will be able to perform miracles by the time you graduate. What we do guarantee, however, is that if you really are a genuine, true-blue believer, you will be able to flow in the mighty manifestations of the Holy Ghost with signs following because you will have been trained to be able to do so, provided you have the genuine faith that works rather than a dead faith lacking the works that Jesus promised to the true-blue believer in John 14:12.

**FAQ 5: Will my certificate from the School of the Sons of the Prophets help me get a job?**

Faith Confession Tabernacle of the Mercy Seat of God has over 2,000 sister churches around the globe. The training you will receive at FCT's School of the Sons of the Prophets is highly esteemed, not only among these sister churches, but even among many non-affiliated Pentecostal and charismatic churches, though some of the Biblical teaching you will receive at our School may be controversial in some of these churches. In addition to applying for employment at one of these local churches, you will also be trained in your field to be a ministerial maverick and start your own ministry or local church wherever you may choose to do so, thus giving you a wide number of possibilities for employment in the Lord's harvest field.

**FAQ 6: How long will it take me to earn my certificate at the School?**

Depending on which certificate you choose to pursue, your time in training may be as little as two years. The most rigorous certification, The Certificate of Prophetic Ministry, will require a bare minimum of five years, but will leave you well-equipped to function the the prophetic capacity. Of course, a person may take his or her time in earning a certificate and there is no need to finish with a certain number

of years. All that is required is that you earn all of the credits specified for the certificate in both the required and elective courses.

**FAQ 7: Can I earn more than one certificate at the School?**

Yes, you may earn as many certificates as you wish, provided you complete all the required and elective credits specified for any particular certificate in the course catalog.

**FAQ 8: Can I just take classes with no intention of pursuing a certificate?**

Yes. You may take any courses you wish as long as you have already taken any prerequisite courses specified in the course catalog.

**FAQ 9: How much will it cost to earn a certificate?**

The least costly certificate is that of the Certified Soul Winner which is estimated at \$15, 984, not including room, board, the cost of a KJV Bible and Strong's Exhaustive Concordance and any books you may wish to purchase. The most costly certificate is The Certificate of Prophetic Ministry which is estimated at around \$60,000. This cost may sound exorbitant or even impossible, but remember that, according to the Word, nothing is impossible with God. Educational loans are available from your financial institution, your local church may help, and generous fee waivers are available for volunteer ministry at Faith Confession Tabernacle. Volunteer ministry may meet some of the practicum requirements of various courses. Contact Sister Ophelia Copperrickel at the church office for more information.

**FAQ 10: Do I have to be a Christian or a Pentecostal or Charismatic in order to attend?**

You must be a born again Christian in order to attend the School of the Sons of the Prophets. If you are not born again and you wish to attend the School, this dilemma can be easily resolved by contacting the church secretary, Sister Ophelia Copperrickel, at the church office between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday. Sister Copperrickel has been trained in assisting you to solve this

dilemma. We urge you to call her now before it is everlastingly too late. If you are a born-again, Bible-believing Christian, but are not a tongue-talking, Holy-Ghost-filled believer, you may enroll courses with the understanding that you are open to being filled with the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking in unknown tongues. The School will not tolerate students who insist on presenting anti-Pentecostal apologetics in order to dissuade others from their own personal Pentecost and ability to tap into the power of God with signs following.



## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS**

(For actual class times, see the Class Schedule which will be mailed to you once your application for admissions has been accepted. Note that some of these classes are only offered once every two or three years. Again, see the new Class Schedule to see which courses are being offered in the current or upcoming semester.)

### **ACT OF BEDDING 101**

Dr. Avery Simpleton guides class discussion around the Scriptures, exploring the origin, purpose, and pleasure of sex within the marriage context, drawing stark contrasts with various acts of fornication. Prerequisite: Dividing the Word 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 2.

### **ACT OF BEDDING 102**

Tyranny Powers, MFT, explores the importance of gender differentiation according to the Word, pointing out the biblical promises of healing for those who suffer the effects of the Fall in this area. Biblical gender roles are emphasized with special attention to proper role differentiation in the act of bedding within the marriage context and how these gender roles deteriorate outside of the marriage context. Prerequisite: Act of Bedding 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### **ACT OF BEDDING 203**

Dr. Avery Simpleton leads the class in an exploration of the effects of Nephilim intrusion in the human genetic code upon human sexuality. Homosex, angelosex, bestiality and other anomalies are investigated in the Scriptures with special attention to proper dealings with these mutational perversions when they express themselves in the marital bedroom. Prerequisite: Act of Bedding 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### **ACT OF BEDDING 204**

Wankford McNutt explores the rubrics of sexual expression within the context of marriage with special attention to the distinguishing elements between equally and unequally-yoked relationships involving

believers and/or unbelievers. Parallels are drawn between the physical, soulish, and spiritual realms. Prerequisite: Act of Bedding 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### ACT OF BEDDING 310

Brother Pete Pandian and Wankford McNutt lead this in-depth Bible exploration of the Song of Solomon, analyzing the various possibilities available within the act of bedding in the context of the marriage setting. The possibility of bedding in the Spirit is touched upon and students are encouraged to learn more about this in the Act of Bedding 435 course. Prerequisite: Act of Bedding 204. Semester: Fall. Credits: 2.

#### ACT OF BEDDING 435

Sister T.L. Pinkerton and Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson plummet into the inner core of the Word to discover the Biblical steps to the exhilarating, marriage re-energizing experience of bedding in the Spirit according to the keys and principles set forth in the inner recesses of the Word of God. Parallels and distinctions are drawn between the experiences of Holy Ghost Yoga, Flying in the Spirit, and bedding in the Spirit, with attention to the suspended state of the natural mind and the flesh. Prerequisite: Act of Bedding 310. Semester: Spring. Credits: 2.

#### ACT OF BEDDING 610

Brother Wankford McNutt discusses some of the surprising effects of tapping into the Feema flow upon the act of bedding within the marital relationship. Many of the principle steps toward Xanadu deeper life are analyzed in relation to the marital act of bedding as a catapult into the deeper things of the Spirit and the possibilities of staking a claim on Enochical faith transfiguration/translation. Prerequisite: Act of Bedding 435. Semester: Summer. Credits: 2.

#### CULTS 101

Dr. Avery Simpleton analyzes the Satanic lies which have been dogmatized by the Watchtower Society and the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints (Mormons). In comparing the cultic teachings of these groups, special attention is given to the definition of “the church” in light of Scripture. In addition, Dr. Simpleton uses Scripture to shine an evaluative spotlight on the formula of Athanasius I, the great Pope

of the Coptic Orthodox Church in Alexandria, who said that “God became man so that man might become God.” Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### CULTS 102

Brother Wilbur Cartwright examines the cultic tendencies of such diverse groups as the Seventh-Day Adventists, the Church of Christ (Campbellite), the Society of Friends (Quakers), the Amish, the Mennonites, and the Hutterites. As always, this class examines their teachings in the light of Scripture and equips students to go out and do battle against certain false reasonings which exalt themselves against the knowledge of God. Prerequisite: Cults 101. Semester: Spring. Credits 3.

#### CULTS 203

Brother Wilbur Cartwright exposes the errors of Christian Science, the Moonies, the Way International, Religious Science, and Scientology pointing out the importance of basing everything on the Bible and interpreting the Bible according to the personal leading of the Holy Spirit in one’s own heart and life rather than according to the opinions of some other person like Mary Baker Eddy, Sun Yung Moon, L. Ron Hubbard, or Joseph Smith, Jr. Also stresses the importance of not throwing the baby out with the bathwater. Prerequisite: Cults 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### CULTS 204

Dr. Avery Simpleton uses the Word of God to demolish the strongholds of Wicca, Satanism, Spiritism, Tarot, Channeling, Ouija, Voodoo, Santeria, Stage Magic, ESP, and the New Age Movement. Special emphasis is given to the authority of the believer over demonic strongholds and the implementation of signs and wonders in the proclamation of the gospel to members of these cults. Also stresses Satan’s lack of originality and how that all of these spiritual practices are counterfeits of the actual real things of God. Prerequisite: Cults 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### CULTS 306

Wankford McNutt explores the cults of Halloween, Santa, the Easter Bunny, Harry Potter, Goths, Star Wars, Star Trek, Lord of the Rings,

and The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe, pointing out the dangers of involvement with these cultic entities, and modeling effective strategies for leading those ensnared in these entrapments into a saving knowledge of Jesus Christ by quoting Scripture repeatedly and unrelentingly “like a hammer which breaketh the rock in pieces.” Prerequisite: Cults 204. Semester: Summer. Credits: 2.

#### CULTS 410

Wankford McNutt exposes the destructive, subversive nature of Freemasonry, Zoroastrianism, Unitarian Universalism, Reformed Judaism, Hinduism, Buddhism, and Bahai, giving practical approaches to persuading those deceived thereby into the Truth that will set them free. Prerequisite: Cults 204. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### CULTS 456

Tyranny Powers, MFT disarms the lies being told by the Homosexual movement, pointing out their erroneous methods of Bible interpretation, their false reliance on science, historical criticism, and reason, and their flesh-based, lust-ridden agenda to corrupt the hearts and minds of our youth through the media and restroom recruitment. Special focus is given to the Metropolitan Community Church and the United Church of Christ as examples of those whom God has judged by giving them over to indecent desires because they believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness. So-called “Gay Pride” is exposed for what it really is—an attempt to sear the conscience and expunge the natural shame of this perversion. Prerequisite: Cults 204. Semester: Spring. Credits 3.

#### CULTS 521

Dr. Avery Simpleton demonstrates how to attack the claims of the Koran and expose it as a Satanic forgery brought forth from the false testimony of one man. The class examines further ways of completely destroying the Moslem’s faith in Islam, inducing a sense of guilt, and then offering a solution to this induced guilt through the gospel message presented in a way a Moslem can understand. The class also discusses the use of the prayer covering the angelic dispatchment in order to protect oneself from retaliation for offending the Moslem sentiment. Students are required to practice the use of these

evangelistic tools in role play. Prerequisite: Cults 204. Semester: Summer. Credits 2.

#### CULTS 608

Dr. Avery Simpleton demonstrates all the various kinds of Anglicanisms which exist, differentiating between the multitude of Anglican sects, all the way from Spongites, to high-church Catholiphiles, to more Bible-based, evangelical forms. The student is taught to avoid making assumptions when someone introduces himself or herself as Anglican or Episcopalian. The centrality of the Word in witnessing is greatly emphasized. Prerequisite: Cults 204. Semester: Spring. Credits 3.

#### CULTS 609

Wankford McNutt thoroughly exposes the Satanic dogmas and lies of the Great Whore, the Papist Roman Catholic Church. Due to the inidious and pervasive doctrines of the Catholic Church, this class meets five hours each week. Connections are drawn between Catholic mariolatry and the pagan religions of Egypt, the middle east, the orient, and South and Central America. Brother McNutt brings to light the Satanic substructure of the monolithic Roman Catholic heresy, exploring its roots in the unbiblical writings of the so-called Apostolic Fathers, the works of Irenaeus, Bishop of Gaul, and the Constantinian Takeover. Special attention is given to Catholic misuse of scripture in attempt to bolster its abominable doctrines. Prerequisite: Cults 204. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### CULTS 610

Wilbur Cartwright brings his experiences working on an evangelistic team one summer in Romania as a springboard for attacking the Satanic stronghold of Eastern Orthodoxy with the battering ram of the Spirit. Prerequisite: Cults 204. Semester: Summer. Credits: 2.

#### DANCING IN THE SPIRIT 101

S.G.R.W. Jackson leads the class in an overview of all the verses in Scripture pertaining to the occurrence of dancing and being moved by the Holy Ghost which occur in the Bible. She delves into both the Hebrew and Greek and reveals the Scriptural underpinnings of the experience of dancing in the Spirit. She also provides students with the

scriptural apologetics needed to answer the objections of the unbelieving. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### DANCING IN THE SPIRIT 102

S.G.R.W. Jackson functions under the anointing to bring students into the experience of dancing in the Spirit, dispelling spiritual obstacles to the experience through the word of knowledge and spiritual warfare. As the power of God begins to move, she stirs up the flames of the Spirit, bringing students into the full release of Holy Ghost dancing. Prerequisite: Dancing in the Spirit 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### DEALING WITH DEMONS 101

Dick Sutkof examines the Old Testament teachings about the origins, authority, power, and methods of demonic forces and their relation to God, Satan, humankind, and the elemental forces of the cosmos. The class also points out how Christians can avoid becoming unwitting instruments of demonic powers. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### DEALING WITH DEMONS 102

Wilbur Cartwright examines the New Testament teachings about demons with special emphasis on the authority given to the believer over these forces of the Enemy. The class examines various ways of dealing with demonization as exemplified by Jesus and the apostles, and stresses the methods by which you can be protected from demonic retaliation for invading their territory. Prerequisite: Dealing with Demons 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### DEALING WITH DEMONS 203

Brother Wankford McNutt looks at various methods of dealing with demons as exemplified in the ministries of Frank and Ida May Hammond, Derek Prince, Judson Cornwall, Smith Wigglesworth, Morris Cerullo, and Dr. Brother Bob Dinkins. Emphasis is laid on the importance of the discerning of spirits and of distinguishing between your common, run-of-the-mill demon and a demonic, legionaire stronghold. The class also looks at demonized material objects and how they can serve to transmit demonic power and how to deal with them. The power of generational curses is also studied. Prerequisites:

Dealing with Demons 102 & Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### DEALING WITH DEMONS 204

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson functions under an anointing of the discerning of spirits, tongues warfare, prophetic drama, and the word of knowledge to deal with the demonic in the lives of each of the class members. The class is purely experiential with occasional reference to the Word at appropriate teaching points as directed by the Holy Ghost. Some members may be called upon to take their authority in dealing with the demonic in their fellow students as the Spirit leads. Prerequisite: Dealing with Demons 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### DEALING WITH DEMONS 310

Sister Tyranny Powers, MFT, provides biblical guidelines for dealing with the spirits of gluttony, homosex perversion, laziness, obsessive compulsion, narcissism, sado-masochism, self-pity, suicide, and trauma in working with those demonized by these unclean spirits. She focuses on the demonic source of these disorders and sets forth battle strategies for putting them to flight. Prerequisite: Dealing with Demons 204. Semester: Summer. Credits: 2.

#### DIVIDING THE WORD 101

Brother Dick Sutkof examines the importance of rightly dividing the Word of Truth by looking at many of the pitfalls of deficient dividing of the Word. The class stresses the importance of postponing verbal utterance of the Word, whether it be in teaching or in your faith confession, until sufficient discernment has been gained so as to have certainty regarding the appropriate application of a particular verse to your teaching or life situation. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### DIVIDING THE WORD 102

Brother Dick Sutkof sets forth the principles for properly dividing the Word in preparation for Spirit-anointed teaching and positive, faith confession. The class also examines ways to ensure the avoidance of improper division of the Word. The ten principles of proper Word

division are studied in depth as outlined in the Word of God. Prerequisite: Dividing the Word 101. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### DIVIDING THE WORD 268

Sister Tyranny Powers, MFT, takes a hard look at the results of cognitive dissonance with the Spirit and the physical and psychological infirmities resulting from improper division of the Word. She offers several case studies from her own ministry and presents guidelines for reversing the effects and breaking the yoke of improper Word division. Prerequisite: Dividing the Word 102. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### END-TIMES PROPHECY 101

Brother Ezekiel T. Abernathy III leads our most popular courses at the School of the Sons of the Prophets. Come get your prophecy fix! Though offered every year, the course material of this class is never exactly the same as current events unfold to usher in the coming of the Lord. Brother Abernathy offers up-to-date, contemporary information and the use of ancient maps, charts, and documents to cast light on the thrilling prophecies of Scripture concerning the proximity of the coming Russo-Moslem attack on Israel, the Rapture Elopement of the Bride, the seven-year tribulation, the conversion of Israel, the Asiatic March on Israel, the Bema Seat of Christ, the Marriage Feast of the Lamb, and all the signs pointing to the nearness of these events. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Time: students must attend the second Saturday of each month, September through December, for an eight-hour, intensive class. Credits: 3.

#### END-TIMES PROPHECY 102

Brother Ezekiel T. Abernathy III delves with mighty, Pentecostal enthusiasm into the mysterious depths of Bible prophecy to reveal the exhilarating secrets of Armageddon, of the global, visible, post-tribulation Third Coming of Christ, the millennial reign, the millennial lifestyle of the raptured vs. that of the unraptured, the millennial temple, millennial sacrificial worship, the Great White Throne Judgment, the torments of Gehenna, and the bliss of the New Heavens and New Earth. Prerequisite: End-Times Prophecy 101. Semester: Spring. Time: students must attend the second Saturday of each month, January through May, for an eight-hour, intensive class. Credits: 3.



### EVANGELISM 101

Brother Wilbur Cartright shares some 20+ years of experience in the full-time evangelistic field. This class searches the Scriptures to discover the definition of evangelism, the call of evangelism, and the purpose of evangelism. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### EVANGELISM 102

Brother Wilbur Cartwright leads this class in a deeper searching of the Scriptures to look at the various means and methods of evangelism in light of the Word. Prerequisite: Evangelism 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### EVANGELISM 203

Brother Wilbur Cartwright focuses the classes attention on the importance of following the leading of the Holy Ghost in evangelistic work. Based on the Word, the student is taught how to identify the leading of the Spirit and how to follow the leading of the Spirit in faith believing. Prerequisites: Evangelism 102 & Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Recommended: Following the Leading 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### EVANGELISM 204

Brother Wilbur Cartwright first focuses on how to witness to the hardened atheist and rebellious sinner, and then takes the class to the highways and hedges in this practical hands-on application of what has been learned in Evangelism 101, 102, and 203. Prerequisite: Evangelism 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### EVANGELISM 205

Brother Dick Sutkof instructs the students of this class in the various ways of attacking the strongholds of homosex, abortion, and Mark-of-Cain worship, and bring a salvific intervention into the lives of those who have been chosen to salvation through the foreknowledge of God. The first half of the class consists of Scripture analysis and training, and the latter half consists of practical application at so-called “Gay Pride” events, abortion clinics and rallies, and Mark-of-Cain rallies. Prerequisite: Evangelism 204. Semester: Summer. Credits: 2.

### FLYING IN THE SPIRIT 101

Brother Pete Pandian takes an in-depth look at the scriptural precedence for flying in the Spirit and the purpose of flying in the Spirit. Each class ends practically with about 20 to 30 minutes of the grounded flight simulation learned in the Pre-Flying class. Prerequisite: Pre-Flying in the Spirit 1A. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### FLYING IN THE SPIRIT 102

Brother Pete Pandian milks the Word to extract the the dangers of flying in the Spirit and the safety measures necessary to avoid crash landings, power failures, rushing, mighty wind pockets, and nose dives. Each class ends practically with about 20 to 30 minutes of the grounded flight simulation learned in the Pre-Flying class. Prerequisite: Flying in the Spirit 101. Semester: Summer. Credits: 2.

### FLYING IN THE SPIRIT 203

Sister T.L. Pinkerton delves into some of the greatest secrets of Holy Scripture, mining deep within the Word to extract the intial steps which prepare one for the full-blown experience of flying in the Spirit. Each class ends practically with about 20 to 30 minutes of the grounded flight simulation learned in the Pre-Flying class. Prerequisite: Pre-Flying in the Spirit 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### FLYING IN THE SPIRIT 204

Sister T.L. Pinkerton reviews the scriptural and practical fundamentals of flying in the Spirit and then dives into the abysmal depths of the Word to discover the actual key of ignition for actual lift-off, with special, personalized application for each student, paying close attention to flight blockages and the importance of rebuking the natural fear of flying by plugging into the supernatural of God. Sister Pinkerton warns the class of dangers, with practical anecdotes from her own spiritual experiences and work as a flight trainer and encourages class members to avoid attempting flight until they are better trained in the Flying in the Spirit 333 class where they can attempt flight in group rather than on their own. Each class ends practically with about 20 to 30 minutes of the grounded flight simulation learned in the Pre-Flying class. Prerequisite: Flying in the Spirit 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### FLYING IN THE SPIRIT 333

Sister T.L. Pinkerton provides practical training on Holy-Ghost levitation, forward and upward thrust, landing skills and precautions, individual blockages and hindrances, turning in the Spirit, and reversal. The class includes several, scheduled flying expeditions in the Spirit with attention to vantage points of spirit-realm operations and management, and training in Holy-Ghost-atomic-bomb release on persons, places, and situations for the purposes of kingdom advancement. Connections are drawn between regular flights in the Spirit and entering into Xanadu Deeper Life and Enochical, faith transfiguration/translation. Prerequisite: Flying in the Spirit 204. Semesters: Summer, Fall, Spring. Credits: 10. (Note: Class sessions for Flying in the Spirit 333 meet three times a week for 3 to 7 hours per session depending on the leading of the Spirit. Students must be willing to devote the necessary time to this anointed discipline.)

### FOLLOW THE LEADING 101

Brother Dick Sutkof leads the class in a close look at the leading of the Holy Ghost as it is seen from Genesis to Revelations. The class focuses on the enmity between the Spirit and the natural mind and the importance of discounting the leadings of the natural mind in order to attune to the leading of the Holy Ghost. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### FOLLOW THE LEADING 102

Brother Pete Pandian opens up the Scripture to reveal the humiliating work of the Spirit in humbling the natural mind and the flesh by leading us to do what is contrary to reason and to our fleshly desires or natural instincts. Students are required to act on one leading of the Spirit contrary to the natural mind in class and write a report on the experience of following one leading outside of class in order to fulfill the practicum portion of this class and earn full credit. Prerequisite: Follow the Leading 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### HELLFIRE TERRORISM 101

Brother Wilbur Cartwright analyzes the reality of hell as delineated in Scripture, also pointing out various misconceptions and heresies regarding hell. The class stresses the importance of the Bible

descriptions in preaching the gospel and shows how hellfire helps to compel God's elect toward salvation by instilling in them the fear of God and how it helps to harden the hearts of the un-elect by provoking them to blaspheme against a holy God. Comparison and contrast is drawn between the persuasive effects of and backlash responses to political terrorism and the Biblical threat of hellfire. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 2.

#### HELLFIRE TERRORISM 102

Brother Wilbur Cartwright uses Scripture, Dante's *INFERNO*, and T.L. Pinkerton's book, *MY MONORAIL RIDE THROUGH HELL*, to support students to develop their own vocabulary of hell to colorize their preaching and increase the power of their evangelistic rhetoric in order to propel precious souls into the kingdom of God. Each student is required to deliver one sermon on hell in front of the class in order to earn full credit. Prerequisite: Hellfire Terrorism 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 2

#### HOLY GHOST BAPTISM 101

Brother Dick Sutkof leads the class through the Bible book by book to unlock the hidden secrets regarding the Baptism in the Holy Ghost. Brother Sutkof presents an overview of church history to reveal how this mighty doctrine went underground for almost two millenia due to persecution by the carnal churches and finally resurfaced under the ministry of Brother Charles F. Parham. Students are also given the opportunity to receive the Baptism if they have not already done so. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 2.

#### HOLY GHOST BAPTISM 102

Brother Dick Sutkof analyzes the objections raised by some of the man-made traditions which hinder them from entering into the fullness of the power of God. He then conducts this practical training class for leading others into the Baptism in the Holy Ghost by requiring scripture memorization and role-play for both persuasive apologetics and anointed prayer with the laying on of hands as a point of contact for the release of the seekers' faith. Brother Sutkof also presents an overview of the various anointed techniques employed by Dr. Brother Bob W. Dinkins, Sister T.L. Pinkerton, Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson, W.V. Grant, Kenneth Hagin, and others for leading seekers into the glorious

experience of the Baptism in the Holy Ghost. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 2.

#### HOLY GHOST REVIVAL 101

Brother Dick Sutkof concentrates on the scriptural passages dealing with the purpose and plan of revival in order to give the student a greater understanding of the why and wherefore of revival. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### HOLY GHOST REVIVAL 102

Brother Wilbur Cartwright focuses the class in on the biblical passages dealing with the preparation for and provocation of revival as a cursory overview of the “how” of revival. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Revival 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### HOLY GHOST REVIVAL 203

Brother Wankford McNutt dives into the Word to stress the possibility and purview of revival with special attention to the impact of revival in modern society, especially in the areas of personal morality, legislation, and the penal code. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Revival 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### HOLY GHOST REVIVAL 204

Brother Pete Pandian extracts honey from the rock of the Word regarding the pleasure and pain of a hot, burning, Holy Ghost revival. Prerequisites: Holy Ghost Baptism 102 & Laughing in the Spirit 102. Please Note that Holy Ghost Revival 203, though recommended, is NOT a prerequisite to this class. Semester: Spring. Credits 3.

#### HOLY GHOST REVIVAL 301

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson mines deep into the core of the Word to get at the power and privilege of revival. This class is experiential in nature and will kindle the cockles of your heart with the burning fires of Holy Ghost revival. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Revival 204. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### HOLY GHOST REVIVAL 410

Sister T.L. Pinkerton delves experientially into the precision and perfection of a true-blue, Holy Ghost revival. This class will set your

whole being aflame with the infectious, inflammatory epidemic of this great, latter-day, Holy Ghost revival and restoration. Also delves into Dr. Dinkin's teachings on the Feema Flow. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost 301. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### HOLY GHOST YOGA 101

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson and Brother Pete Pandian co-lead this introductory course in Holy Ghost Yoga as it was revealed to Sister Jackson. The course begins with a brief analysis and discussion of the Biblical underpinnings of Holy Ghost Yoga and its benefits for the individual Christian, the church, and the world and quickly delves into the experiential practicum of this course which is sure to re-energize your spiritual life. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### HOLY GHOST YOGA 102

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson and Brother Pete Pandian co-lead this intermediate course in Holy Ghost Yoga as it was revealed to Sister Jackson. Attention is given to target personal blockages in each student's spirit-man in order to bring a deepening and a release of pent-up spiritual energies for an increase of abundance on the physical, soulish, and spiritual planes. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Yoga 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### HOLY GHOST YOGA 203

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson helps each student ascertain deeper spiritual blockages and find practical, personalized approaches to using H.G. Yoga to dovetail with Dr. Dinkin's teaching on tapping into the Feema Flow. Stress is placed on disciplined usage of and full, yielded abandon to the spiritual prayer language as the primary means by which we are enabled to blast through the layers of spiritual rock in order to release the Feemic artesian. Prerequisites: Holy Ghost Yoga 102 and Holy Ghost Revival 410. Semester: Summer. Credits: 2.

#### INHALING THE GLORY 251

Brother Pete Pandian follows the leading of the Spirit as he conducts this experiential practicum on inhaling and administering the Shekinah Glory. Anyone who has met the prerequisites is highly encouraged to take this practicum involving an experiential deepening occurring right

at the cutting edge of the Holy Ghost revival vanguard. Prerequisite: Laughing in the Spirit 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 2.

#### JUDAISM FOR CHRISTIANS 101

Rabbi Mordechai Lemsley Goldberg, D.Div., provides an historical and Biblical overview of the Hebraic roots of the Church and the invasion of Greek and Latin gentilisms which corrupted common understanding of the Scriptures and gave rise to carnal churchianity and eventually the Great Whore and her Eastern twin sister. Rabbi Goldberg advocates the sanctification of life through the prescriptions of the Torah for daily life among both Jewish and Gentile believers and substantiates this advocacy with a thorough investigation of the Word. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. (This is an intensive course requiring attendance for two, seven-hour days per month, TBA, from September through December.) Credits: 3.

#### JUDAISM FOR CHRISTIANS 102

Rabbi Mordechai Lemsley Goldberg, D.Div., leads this practicum-based course in the messianic revival of the Seven Feasts of the Lord along with Hanukkah and Purim. In addition, students will be taught Jewish-dance worship forms, messianic Torah Haggadoth, Holy-Ghost mishnaic applications, and effective ways of promoting Judaic practice among Gentile believers together with practical means of supporting the power of the nation-state of Israel, the removal of the Dome of the Rock, and the reconstruction of the temple in Jerusalem in preparation for the Great Tribulation and the abomination that maketh desolate at the 3½ year point. Prerequisite: Judaism for Christians 101. Semester: Spring. (This is an intensive course requiring attendance for two, seven-hour days per month, TBA, from January through May.) Credits: 3.

#### LAUGHING IN THE SPIRIT 101

Brother Pete Pandian and Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson co-lead this exciting, experiential exploration into the pneumatometrics of Holy Ghost intoxication and laughing under the influence. An initial overview of the Scriptural foundations for laughing in the Spirit are covered, with a brief look at an anthology of Holy Laughter Studies. Prerequisite: Natural Mind Loss 103. Semester: Fall. Credits: 2.

### LAUGHING IN THE SPIRIT 102

Brother Pete Pandian and Sister T.L. Pinkerton serve up the Spirit straight from Heaven's Tap and bring class participants into the experience of spiritual blackout and Holy Ghost joy addiction. Distinctions are drawn between Holy Ghost intoxication and the Shekinah high, and class members are encouraged to "follow on to know the Lord" in the Inhaling the Glory 251 course. Prerequisite: Laughing in the Spirit 102. Semester: Spring. Credits: 2.

### LOVE CHANNEL 101

Brother Dick Sutkof examines the essential principals and precursors to functioning in love and ministering from the overflow in the spontaneity of true liberty in the Holy Ghost. The class examines personal, cultural, and ecclesial blockages which prevent the funneling of love into those hard-to-reach crevices of the precious souls to whom we are led to minister. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### LOVE CHANNEL 102

Dr. Avery Simpleton instructs class members to let go of the shoreline and launch out into the deep as they set aside all the preconceptions of the natural mind to become pure channels of Divine Love. The class offers practicums to apply many of the principals learned in Natural Mind Loss 103 and Love Channel 101 as class members set aside their own mind, will, and emotions, in order to funnel Divine Love into those hard-to-reach crevices of fellow class members and hone in on the God-shaped hole within each of them for the purpose of filling it with Him. Prerequisite: Natural Mind Loss 103. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### LOVE CHANNEL 268

Tyranny Powers, MFT, leads this Holy Ghost therapeutic practicum in order to deal with love blockages within the student body. Sister Powers relies heavily on the word of knowledge and the discerning of spirits as she targets points of trauma, emotional woundings, and spirit-man imbalances in order to transform her students into unblocked channels of the Love of God. Prerequisite: Love Channel 102. Semesters: Fall, Spring, Summer. Credits: 3.



#### MINISTERING TO THE SICK 101

Wilbur Cartwright examines the Scriptures proving the inappropriate placement of faith in doctors. He instructs class members on how to steer the sick away from faith in medicine through humor, personal anecdote, and Scripture quotation and point them toward the power of God. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### MINISTERING TO THE SICK 102

Wankford McNutt guides the class in a study of the Scriptures, stressing both the power and willingness of God to heal while also emphasizing the necessity of a positive faith confession in order to align with the will of God and tap into the healing power. Prerequisite: Ministering to the Sick 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### MINISTERING TO THE SICK 203

Wilbur Cartwright focuses on the function of faith in the minister's anointing. He guides the class in a thorough study of the Scriptures dealing with pre-point-of-contact, faith preparation and demonstrates good presentation which supports faith in the anointing. The class then uses role play to practice proper, faith-building presentation and delivery. Prerequisite: Ministering to the Sick 102 or Releasing Your Faith 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### MINISTERING TO THE SICK 204

Wankford McNutt provides practical instruction on the actual moment of contact faith-release and how to milk that moment to bring a real breakthrough. Attention is given to the importance of openness to the word of knowledge and the word of wisdom at such moments. A brief glance at the power of the Feema flow and the importance of a ministering faith filter to prevent soul implosion and spirit-man circuitry override. An in-depth formulation regarding post-point-of contact faith instruction is presented and practiced in role-play practicums. Prerequisite: Ministering to the Sick 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### MINISTERING TO THE SICK 268

Sister Tyranny Powers, MFT, provides practical guidelines for attacking the powers of the enemy which have set up camp in the bodies, souls, and spirits of the mentally ill. She stresses heavy leaning

upon the discerning of spirits and the word of knowledge when dealing with these issues, points out mind/body/spirit dissonances and their effects, models love release and love-center return, and gives detailed guidelines for bringing deliverance to the mentally ill, especially those suffering from neuroses, homosex perversion, gluttony, self-pity, and narcissistic, anorexic, bolemic, bipolar, depressive, and reactive attachment disorders. Prerequisite: Ministering to the Sick 204. Semesters: Fall and Spring. Credits: 3.

#### NATURAL MIND LOSS 103

Dr. Avery Simpleton conducts this in-depth Scriptural analysis of the tripartite nature of man and God. The clear distinctions of Scripture which separate the natural, soulish mind from the spirit-man are highlighted with a view to ministerial, eschatological, and pneumatological implications. Student's are required to memorize the seven keys to natural mind loss together with verses backing up each key. (Note: meets 4 to 6 hours per week, depending on the leading of the Holy Ghost. Students are expected to keep those hours reserved as classtime.) Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 4.

#### OFFERING TAKING 101

Brother Dick Sutkof guides the class in an overview of the Old Testament principles regarding tithes, offerings, love gifts, and faith vows with attention to both inner and outer essentials of performance and the material, soulish, and spiritual blessings associated with various modes of giving. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### OFFERING TAKING 102

Brother Dick Sutkof guides the class in an overview of the New Testament principles regarding tithes, offerings, love gifts, and faith vows with attention to both inner and outer essentials of performance and the material, soulish, and spiritual covenantal blessings associated with various modes of giving. The class will spend half of the semester discovering rich secrets regarding the relationship of the Melchizedekian priesthood to the promise of increase and abundance. Prerequisite: Offering Taking 102. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### OFFERING TAKING 203

Dr. Avery Simpleton guides the class in discovering the practicalities of applying the knowledge gained in Offering Taking 101 and 102 to the concrete act of offering taking. The class looks at the history of offering taking in Israel, the apostolic church, carnal churchianity, and the the spiritual church. Students are required to take scriptural knowledge gained in Offering Taking 101 and 102 and communicate it in an effective manner in two offering taking practicums. Prerequisite: Offering Taking 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### OFFERING TAKING 204

Dr. Avery Simpleton focuses the class on the importance of getting past the natural mind in the spiritual act of offering taking. Stress is laid on the importance of stressing to believers the priesthood of the believer in the act of taking offerings offered by believers functioning in both the act of giving and taking offerings as a beautiful picture of sowing and reaping the abundance Jesus promised. Students are required to exhibit some Spirit-led actions as they fulfil the requirement of participating in three offering taking practicums. Prerequisite: Offering Taking 203 and Natural Mind Loss 103. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### OFFERING TAKING 306

Wankford McNutt looks at the relationship between heart-strings and purse-strings in the act of offering taking. Practical methods of building expectation in the giver are delineated and practiced in several required practicums. Stress is laid on the importance of stressing to the giver the importance of giving out of one's need rather than out of abundance in order to produce a greater harvest. Prerequisite: Offering Taking 204. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### OFFERING TAKING 410

Wankford McNutt focuses on the importance of circumventing the natural aversions of the totally depraved nature of the flesh to the spiritual act of offering taking. He gives insightful techniques for shaming the natural man and the carnal mind while also motivating the spirit-man to take control and act in the face of opposition from the flesh to give not simply out of abundance, but to give out of need and to do it in faith. Prerequisite: Offering Taking 204. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### OFFERING TAKING 456

Wilbur Cartwright analyzes the power of material objects and sensory input in the act of offering taking. He offers practical techniques for stimulating the same kind of critical mass, offering propulsion he's seen in his own ministry on the evangelistic field. He focuses on the inseparable relationship between the revival Spirit and the giving spirit, looking at the obvious connection between the Spirit of laughter and the spirit of hilarity mentioned by the Apostle Paul, and stresses the importance of capitalizing on the joy of the Holy Ghost. Prerequisite: Offering Taking 204. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### OFFERING TAKING 603

Brother Wilbur Cartwright demonstrates practical techniques for impelling congregations to give in a manner which bypasses the concerns and thought processes of the natural mind. The class looks at parallels between absorption in TV, in driving, and other meditative acts and provides ways for inducing such absorption in the act of giving. Stress is placed on the importance of inciting antithetical emotional reactions within the audience, such as both fear and relief, laughter and pain, boredom and excitement, and embarrassment and pride as a child of God in order to support the faithful in the act of giving. Attention is also given to the place of demonic strongholds. Prerequisite: Offering Taking 204. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### OIL OF JOY MASSAGE 251

Brother Pete Pandian conducts this practical, hands-on training in the spiritual, therapeutic art of oil-of-joy massage. Attention is given to spiritual blockages to the flow of the Spirit and how these blockages become imprisoned or encapsulated in the flesh. Scriptural distinctions are drawn between right and left, between joints and marrow, soul and spirit, brain and heart, kidneys and liver, hinderparts and belly, and various other bodily members and the role they play in maintaining blockages and also in releasing the oil of joy. The ultimate focus is on bringing full release to the captives through the application of the oil of joy. Prerequisite: Inhaling the Glory 251. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### PLEADING THE BLOOD 101

Brother Dick Sutkof leads this practicum on pleading the blood with attention also given to the methodologies of placing a prayer covering and also placing a hedge about someone. Distinctions are drawn between each of these acts with special focus on how to diagnose to determine which intervention is needed in various situations. The scriptural precedence for each of these is analyzed and each class ends with 15 to 20 minutes of a prayer practicum to be applied to real life situations. Each class begins with a time of testimony regarding the benefits derived from these powerful interventions. Prerequisite: Rebuking the Devil 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### PRAISE & WORSHIP 101

Dr. Avery Simpleton analyzes the Scriptures to draw a sharp distinction between the fleshly, liturgical religiosity of Old Testament worship and the spiritual, spontaneous liberty of New Testament worship. The presence of the Spirit is stressed as the decisive factor distinguishing the two forms and emphasis is laid on the importance of unleashing the Spirit and encouraging the manifestation of the Spirit in worship. The class also distinguishes between songs and hymns as ways of getting into the Spirit which is then manifested by spiritual songs and other spiritual manifestations. The importance of dancing is also underlined. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### PRAISE & WORSHIP 102

Dr. Avery Simpleton guides the class on a tour through Scripture to look at the various elements of spontaneous worship in the liberty of the Spirit. The Biblical precedence for various spiritual manifestations is discussed, including, singing, dancing, laughing, weeping, falling, rolling, crawling, slithering, groaning, moaning, shaking, and giving forth tongues, barnyard noises, and jungle calls. Sharp contrasts are again drawn between liturgical religiosity and true worship in Spirit and in truth. Prerequisite: Praise & Worship 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### PRAISE & WORSHIP 203

Brother Pete Pandian leads this class as a practical, instructive worship service as he unleashes the power of the Holy Ghost and manifest in an

instructive manner among the students. He models how to unleash the Spirit and how to elicit the manifestations of the Spirit among the members of a congregation. He stresses that there are deeper experiences in God and that we should not limit ourselves to the common manifestations such as laughing, dancing, or talking in tongues. Prerequisites: Holy Ghost Baptism 102 & Praise & Worship 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### PRAISE & WORSHIP 204

Brother Pete Pandian stresses the fact that God is always doing a new thing and we cannot contain the new wine of the Spirit in the old wine bottles of yesterday's move of God. He emphasizes how easily the move of the Spirit can become a tradition which, in turn, hampers the move of God and puts the Holy Spirit back on the leash of human comfort and conventionality. He demonstrates the freshness of the Song of the Lord, which should never be written down lest we substitute the written form for the spontaneous Song, and also points to his own life and ministry as evidence of the ever-new move of the Spirit. He allows the Spirit to exhibit for class members such cutting-edge manifestations as glory-honking and whistling in tongues. He incites faith in the class members to be open to new manifestations and encourages these fresh manifestations in the practicum portion of the class. Prerequisite: Praise & Worship 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### PRE-FLYING IN THE SPIRIT 1A

Brother Pete Pandian presents a very brief overview of the Scriptural precedents for flying in the Spirit and then immerses the students in an engaging practicum for faith-edification, flesh humiliation, natural mind suspension, and spirit-man arousal through grounded flight simulations in preparation for actual flight in the Spirit to be experienced in later courses in the Flying in the Spirit series. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 2.

#### PROPHECY 101

Dr. Avery Simpleton provides an overview of the nature of prophecy and its occurrences from the times of Enoch to the present day, highlighting the wide variety of prophetic expression, the personal, ecclesial, and societal impact of prophecy, and the distinction between

one who prophecies and the office of a prophet. Attention is also given to the manner in which prophecy dovetails with other gifts of the Spirit. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### PROPHECY 102

Brother Wankford McNutt analyzes various techniques used by God's people over the centuries to open themselves up to become channels of the prophetic. Particular emphasis is laid upon music, fasting, dancing, and self-humiliation as means of inducing the prophetic state. Brother Wankford also leads class members in practicums to develop these techniques in preparation for prophetic demonstration in Prophecy 203. Prerequisite: Prophecy 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### PROPHECY 203

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson leads this experiential induction into prophetic functioning, focusing on the manifestation of prophecy on the personal, corporate, and societal levels. She draws heavily upon her own personal experience as a prophetess of God in the founding and operation of the Jacksonian Institute. She models the use of various techniques for inducing the prophetic state. Students are required to operate in the practicum portion of the class under Paul's injunction that "ye may all prophesy." Prerequisites: Holy Ghost Baptism 102 & Prophecy 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### PROPHECY 204

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson continues to enforce the experiential practicum portion of the class while also stressing the authority of prophecy. Attention is given to the evaluation of prophecies and Paul's injunction to "hold fast to that which is good." The importance of and guidelines for maintaining a church prophetic archive is emphasized. The class compares the authority of Scripture with the authority of bonified prophecies, stressing that the true authority lies within the private assumption of prophetic injunctions by the individual believer. Prerequisites: Natural Mind Loss 103 and Prophecy 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### PROPHECY 319

Brother Pete Pandian leads this Biblical study and practicum beyond the verbal manifestation of prophecy to the manifestation of prophetic

drama, non-verbal theatrics, and Holy-Ghost-led choreography. The possibility and promise of communal choreographic manifestation in worship is set forth with warnings drawn from the fate of the Shaker movement, stressing the rejection of the institutionalization of the Spirit's movements in dead traditionalism and emphasizing ways of kindling and stoking the fires of immediate inspiration from the Spirit. Prerequisite: Prophecy 204 or Inhaling the Glory 251. Semester: Summer. Credits: 2.

#### PROSPERING YOUR FLOCK 101

Wankford McNutt leads this in-depth Bible analysis of the twelve principles for prospering your local church community. Particular stress is laid upon the repercussions of success, abundance, and prosperity which ensue in the lives of the faithful through Storehouse overflow. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### PROSPERING YOUR FLOCK 102

Wilbur Cartwright analyzes the systemic nature of prosperity and the switches available to the minister for triggering increase, abundance, and overflow within the local church. Brother Cartwright draws from his own personal experience to demonstrate how to coordinate increase switches and channel triggers with the twelve principles for prospering the local church as learned in Prospering Your Flock 101. Brother Cartwright demonstrates through personal anecdote and Word-based diagrams how the wealth of the wicked is laid up for the righteous. Prerequisite: Prospering Your Flock 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### REBUKING THE DEVIL 101

Wankford McNutt leads this Bible-based practicum on rebuking the Enemy. Stress is laid on warfare preparation, armament, battle strategies, waylaying maneuvers, vocal intonation, reverberation, hand gesture binding, entrapment, and P.O.W. retention for the express purpose of spoiling the goods. Emphasis is also laid upon tactical plundering with no stone left unturned. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.



### RELEASING YOUR FAITH 101

Brother Dick Sutkof leads this informative Bible discussion of the nine principles of faith release for breakthrough reception. The Scriptural dictum that “the violent take it by force” is related to each of the nine principles of faith release and students are encouraged to apply the principles to receive their own personal breakthrough. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### RELEASING YOUR FAITH 102

Dr. Avery Simpleton delves into the Greek and Hebrew, using Strong’s Concordance in order to milk the riches of the Word for further edification for the release of faith. Special attention is given to the function of the Throne of Grace as a functional hotseat of spiritual contact. The role of spirit-man perceptivity is extracted through word studies and emphasis is laid upon the role this perceptivity plays in wall breachment, contact boundary displacement, faith release, and the act of calling-it-done-based-on-the-Word. Prerequisite: Strong’s Concordance Maximization 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### RELEASING YOUR FAITH 203

Sister T.L. Pinkerton leads this Biblically-based practicum in faith release through the use of points of contact. She explores effective strategies for designating points of contact in order to maximize faith release in various areas of functionality. She demonstrates the effects of faith release contact in unleashing such spiritual manifestations as groaning in the Spirit and electrocutinary, pneumatic convulsions. Students are required to designate their own effective point of contact and utilize it for faith release within the context of the learning environment. Prerequisite: Releasing Your Faith 102 or Laughing in the Spirit 102. Semester: Summer. Credits: 2.

### SERPENT HANDLING 101

Brother Wankford McNutt explores the scriptural precedent and directive for the taking up of serpents. Serpent symbology is analyzed with a view to spiritual warfare and dominion. Stress is laid on justifying faith as a faith of works which automatically results in the miraculous works of Jesus, the apostles, and even greater than their

works being manifest in the lives of those who truly believe. Prerequisite: Signs & Wonders 102 and Love Channel 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### SERPENT HANDLING 102

Brother Wankford McNutt opens the Word to behold the impossibility of full proclamation of the Gospel without the full manifestation of the signs of the Lord working with the preacher of the Gospel. The rejection of serpent handling by many so-called “full gospel” groups is analyzed and debunked and the importance of the anointing is stressed above all. Prerequisite: Serpent Handling 101 or Strichnine 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### SERPENT HANDLING 203

Brother Wilbur Cartwright gives the demonstration of the Spirit and power as he models obedience to the anointing in the taking up of serpents. Students are only required to observe rather than participate. The importance of anointed music and glossalalia is stressed and caution is given to those who would attempt to handle serpents outside of the anointing. The class also looks at the beneficial effects in the spirit realm of Holy Ghost dominion over serpents. Prerequisite: Serpent Handling 102 or Strichnine 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### SERPENT HANDLING 204

Brother Wankford McNutt and Brother Wilbur Cartwright lead this practicum course in the taking up of serpents under the anointing of the Holy Ghost. The class is basically a Word-based, Spirit-filled worship service with anointed music and encouragement from the instructors for students to flow in the anointing and exercise their authority and liberty in the Spirit to take up serpents in the name of Jesus. The class begins with the use of non-poisonous snakes and advances through increasingly poisonous ones to the most lethal. Students are required to sign a waiver prior to participation. Prerequisites: Follow the Leading 102 and Serpent Handling 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### SHEKINAH WEAVING 101

Brother Pete Pandian leads this interactive practicum module on weaving the Shekinah glory cloud. Students will be encouraged to weave the glory cloud in their own personal devotions prior to

attempting to do so in a public setting. Scriptural precedents and spirit/body gesture techniques are analyzed and implemented. Stress is placed upon displacing soulish blockages to the spirit/body connection in order to manifest the Shekinah glory cloud in the context of one's own personal devotions and public worship. Brother Pandian opens the Word to reveal the nine essential ingredients to glory cloud production and the seven hindrances to successful weaving of the Shekinah glory cloud. Prerequisite: Oil of Joy Massage 101. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### SIGNS & WONDERS 101

Dr. Avery Simpleton conducts this exploration of the diverse means and expressions in the manifestation of signs and wonders in the Old Testament. Attention is given to reproducibility, the importance of spiritual resonance, and the sparing use of punitive miracles. Prerequisite: None. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### SIGNS & WONDERS 102

Wankford McNutt, M.Div., leads the class in an in-depth study of the diversity of means and expression in the manifestation of signs and wonders in the New Testament. Attention is given to the principle of faith linkage between heaven and earth, simulative faith release, and the conditions for the sparing use of punitive miracles. Prerequisite: Signs & Wonders 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### SIGNS & WONDERS 203

Wilbur Cartwright, M.A., explores the experience of signs in the heavens such as sun-darkening, blood-moons, quasars, blood, fire, and vapor of smoke with some attention to the return of the Nephilim and alien abduction. He draws both from the Scriptures and from abundant personal experience of signs and wonders in his own ministry. The practicum portion of the class involves the identification of sign/wonder necessity, entitlement claim, natural-mind bypass, faith confession, and point-of-contact faith release. Prerequisite: Signs & Wonders 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### SIGNS & WONDERS 204

Sister T.L. Pinkerton leads this experiential practicum in the manifestation of a wide diversity of signs and wonders including

aquambulation, aquahaematization, aquapartition, baculocoluberation, lithoscindation, monstraduction, photagogia, prestofermentation, ranogenesis, resodeletion, resomultiplication, and spiritocaecation. Students are expected to attempt to perform at least one tiny sign or wonder in order to receive full credit. Prerequisite: Signs & Wonders 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### SINGING IN TONGUES 101

Pete Pandian leads this deep Scripture study in both Old and New Testaments to discover the pleasures, privileges, and products of singing in tongues. Brother Pandian's rich Bible study is bejeweled with sudden and spontaneous manifestations of singing in tongues and a tongue-singing practicum climaxes each class. The class also explores the gift of whistling in tongues and its relationship to the delights of the love-bannered bedchamber of the heavenly Bride and the earthly, marital bed. Prerequisites: Holy Ghost Baptism 102 and Tongue Talk 101. Semester: Summer. Credits: 3.

#### SLAY LINE 101

Brother Wankford McNutt leads the class in a thorough investigation of the experience of being slain in the Spirit as it occurs in the Old and New Testaments. Parallels in voodooism, hinduism, and other heathen religions are debunked. Brother McNutt uses his own experience as both slayer and slayee to enrich the class discussion and each class ends with an opportunity for class members to be slain at the hands of Brother McNutt. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### SLAY LINE 102

Brother Wilbur Cartwright looks at a post-Biblical historical overview of the phenomenon of falling out under the power. Brother Cartwright also leads the class in a word study of the Word "slain" in the Bible and other such words related to the phenomenon of the being slain in the Spirit. The class also looks at other supernatural events which commonly accompany the experience such as light flashes, hot flashes, time distortions, blackouts, healings, false memories, visions, convulsions, and glossalalic utterances. Prerequisite: Slay Line 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### SLAY LINE 203

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson focuses in on the transference of Holy-Ghost slaying power through physical techniques such as puffing, hand-forehead contact, wrist-flinging, suit-jacket whippings, sweat sprinkling, amplified hollers, and firing the invisible Holy-Ghost pistol. She also looks at the importance of building faith and openness in the audience. She touches upon the subtle communications of faith by examining some basic principles of Neurolinguistic Programming to be used in the service of the Lord for greater manifestations and responsiveness among congregants. Prerequisite: Slay Line 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### SLAY LINE 204

Sister T.L. Pinkerton treats in depth the principles of spirit-man manipulation and collision through Holy-Ghost Powerball and Glory Intensification techniques. She leads several practicums, modeling the technique of “priming the pump” to produce a sensational, self-maintaining slay-line production line. She also covers behind-the-scene and stage fundamentals necessary to become a fail-proof, reputed slay-power-slinging man or woman of God in order to incite faith and bring results. Prerequisite: Slay Line 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### SLAY LINE 306

Sister Tyranny Powers, M.F.T., assists the class in exploration of Divine and Satanic power differentials which play a role in operating switch-gates and power flow regulators affecting the intensity and quality of Holy-Ghost zap conduction and its effects. Sister Powers reveals seven secrets which will aid the slay-line minister to increase beneficial results of falling under the power while decreasing detrimental effects of demonic operations upon those who thus yield in openness to the spiritual realm. The role of ethnic and cultural diversity is touched upon in order to increase the minister’s awareness of these issues and their influence upon the slain. Prerequisite: Slay Line 204. Semester: Summer. Credits: 3.

### STRICHNINE 101

Dr. Avery Simpleton explores the scriptural precedent and directive for the drinking of poisons. Poison symbology is analyzed with a view to

rebuking mortality and dominion over death. Stress is laid on justifying faith as a faith of works which automatically results in the miraculous works of Jesus, the apostles, and even greater than their works being manifest in the lives of those who truly believe. Prerequisites: Signs & Wonders 102 and Love Channel 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### STRICHNINE 102

Dr. Avery Simpleton opens the Word to behold the impossibility of full proclamation of the Gospel without the full manifestation of the signs of the Lord working with the preacher of the Gospel. The rejection of strichnine imbibing by many so-called “full gospel” groups is analyzed and debunked and the importance of the anointing is stressed above all. Prerequisite: Strichnine 101 or Serpent Handling 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### STRICHNINE 203

Brother Wankford McNutt gives the demonstration of the Spirit and power as he models obedience to the anointing in the drinking of strichnine. Students are only required to observe rather than participate. The importance of health-level faith is stressed and caution is given to those who would attempt to imbibe strichnine apart from the leading of the Holy Spirit. The class also looks at the beneficial effects on the physical, soulish, and spiritual plains of Holy Ghost dominion over deadly beverages. Prerequisite: Strichnine 102 or Serpent Handling 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### STRICHNINE 204

Brother Wankford McNutt and Brother Wilbur Cartwright lead this practicum course in the drinking of strichnine at the behest of the Holy Spirit. The class is basically a Word-based, Spirit-filled worship service with anointed music and encouragement from the instructors for students to flow in the anointing and exercise their authority and liberty in the Spirit to exercise dominion over death through the drinking of strichnine. The class begins with the use of irritating, non-poisonous beverages and advances through increasingly poisonous ones to a lethal concentration of strichnine. Students are required to sign a waiver prior to participation. Prerequisites: Follow the Leading 102 and Strichnine 203. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### STRONG'S CONCORDANCE MAXIMIZATION 101

Brother Dick Sutkof introduces the concept of the “word-study” and presents the first four principles for maximizing information gleaned in the performance of a word-study: the principles of first occurrence definition, last occurrence definition, synonym searching, and Hebrew/Greek alternate definition. Prerequisite: Dividing the Word 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### STRONG'S CONCORDANCE MAXIMIZATION 102

Dr. Avery Simpleton presents the next five principles for maximizing information gleaned in the performance of a word-study: the principles of alternate definition substitution, Greek/Hebrew equivalent substitution, English synonym substitution, Hebrew/Greek etymology milking, and chronometric, statistical logological equation. Prerequisite: Strong's Concordance Maximization 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

### STRONG'S CONCORDANCE MAXIMIZATION 103

Brother Wilbur Cartwright presents the last three principles for maximizing information gleaned in the performance of a word-study: word occurrence meaning sequencing, gematric meaning derivation, and Hebrew/Greek letter analysis. Prerequisite: Strong's Concordance Maximization 102. Semester: Summer. Credits: 3.

### SUPERNATURAL PROSPERITY 101

Brother Wankford McNutt conducts a comprehensive overview of the Biblical keys to supernatural prosperity. He incorporates the exegetical methodology of Brother Frederick K.C. Price, Brother Creflo Dollar, Brother Robert Tilton, Brother Errol Rothberts, Dr. Brother Bob Dinkins and other great men of God in order to prepare the student for a deluge of supernatural abundance in his/her life and ministry. Prerequisite: Dividing the Word 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

### SUPERNATURAL PROSPERITY 102

Brother Wilbur Cartwright covers the practical implementation of the key principles introduced in Supernatural Prosperity 101 using personal anecdote from 15 years of full-time, on-the-road ministry, Biblical motifs, and role-play to train students in the activation of

supernatural increase in their lives and ministry so that the laborer is not only worthy of his hire, but in the position to receive his hire along with Holy Ghost bonuses, pressed down, shaken together, and running over. Prerequisite: Supernatural Prosperity 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### TONGUES INTERPRETATION 101

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson introduces the stream of Holy Ghost consciousness and presents the methodology and techniques of entering into this spiritual stream of consciousness, emphasizing the role it plays in the interpretation of tongues. Prerequisites: Natural Mind Loss 103 and Tongue Talk 102. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### TONGUES INTERPRETATION 102

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson leads this practicum in the interpretation of tongues, stressing that not one syllable in the truly-inspired interpretation of tongues is a mistake. She trains students in the skill of faith recovery during a seeming interpretational glitch and teaches them how to sink a deeper, more productive well of interpretational flow into the belly of their spirit-man. Prerequisite: Tongues Interpretation 101. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### TONGUE TALK 101

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson leads students on a Word exploration of the restful and refreshing benefits of the daily exercise of one's personal prayer language. She stresses the importance of building the vocabulary of one's spirit-man through a daily, loquacious effusion of tongue talk and closes each class with a vocabulary-building practicum. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Summer. Credits: 3.

#### TONGUE TALK 102

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson introduces the exhilarating experience of dialogical tongue talk. She explores the possibility and promise of conversational tongues as based on the Word, offers techniques for becoming more conversant and tongue receptive, and closes each class with a half-hour practicum of communing with one another's spirit-man through plunging deep via the divers-tongues-communion of the



Holy Ghost. Prerequisite: Tongue Talk 101. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### VISIONS & DREAMS 101

Sister T.L. Pinkerton uses a blend of personal anecdote and Word exploration to guide students in the interpretation of their own dreams. Students are required to maintain a Dream Log throughout the course. Sister Pinkerton stresses that the imagery used by the Holy Ghost in the Word is the same imagery used by the Holy Ghost in our dreams. Prerequisites: Holy Ghost Baptism 102, Dividing the Word 102, and Strong's Concordance Maximization 103. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### VISIONS & DREAMS 102

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson guides students in developing a dream-image dictionary to aid in the interpretation of their own dreams and those of others. Students are required to continue the maintenance of a personal Dream Log while also making their own dream-image dictionary. Stress is laid on the unity of the Word/Dream imagery and students are required to interpret other students' dreams during the practicum portion. Prerequisite: Visions & Dreams 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### WORD OF KNOWLEDGE 101

Tyranny Powers, M.F.T., uses personal anecdote, Word analysis, and the technique of faith-horizon fixation in order to lay the bedrock foundation for students to begin to flow in the Word of Knowledge. Sister Powers explores parallels found in quantum physics and dream mapping which can serve as techniques to open the student's spirit-man to receive a great influx of Word-of-Knowledge operations. She stresses the importance of the Word of Knowledge in purging the Church of pride, prejudice, poverty, plague, and perversion. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### WORD OF KNOWLEDGE 102

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson presents techniques for tapping into and channeling the stream of Holy Ghost consciousness into Word-of-Knowledge release. She emphasizes entry into the domain of faith-level specificity in Word-of-Knowledge transmission. The greater portion of the class is practicum-based as Sister Jackson coaches

students to function in the Word of Knowledge as they minister to one another's real-life needs. Prerequisite: Word of Knowledge 101. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### WORD OF WISDOM 101

Dr. Avery Simpleton explores the manifestations of the word of wisdom as depicted in the Word. He stresses the neglect of this gift among believers and encourages students to consider the possibility of developing a ministry centered around the manifestation of this much-neglected gift of the Spirit. Prerequisite: Holy Ghost Baptism 102. Semester: Summer. Credits: 3.

#### WORD OF WISDOM 102

Sister S.G.R.W. Jackson models word-of-wisdom directives which challenge the spirit-man of each student to rise up in victory. Sister Jackson presents seven principles of word-of-wisdom release. The class covers the hunt, seizure, containment, inflation, explosion, release, and transmission of the Holy-Ghost word of wisdom. Prerequisite: Word of Wisdom 101. Semester: Fall. Credits: 3.

#### WORD OF WISDOM 203

Brother Wankford McNutt assists students to attune the ears of their spirit-man to the cry of Wisdom transmitted on the frequency resonating between natural need and supernatural abundance. Brother Wankford orients students to the dials of their own spirit-man radio receptors and trains them in adjusting pneumatic antennae to receive a clearer word. Prerequisite: Word of Wisdom 102. Semester: Spring. Credits: 3.

#### WORD OF WISDOM 204

Wankford McNutt coordinates bilocutional, sensory manipulations for deriving sophic profusions in the realm of spirit-man morphology with a view to cortical stimulation via throne bolt discharge. Containment of the crystallized dew of wisdom precipitate is emphasized for the express purpose of detonating the wisdom of the world through proper soul-burrowing, sub-rational-acumen deposit, Word priming, manual imposition fusilage placement, and glossalalial ignition. Prerequisites: Word of Wisdom 203, Releasing Your Faith 203, and Act of Bedding 610. Semester: Spring. Credits: 5.
