

# The Domino Slay-Line Effect




What a mighty anointing at the crusade in Milwaukee, last week! By the end of each evening, over a thousand cheeseheads were strewn about the stadium field clear out to the 50 yard line, flat on their backs under the power of God. What a glorious time in God!

Many people, mostly other ministers, have asked me, "Dr. Dinkins, what's the secret to slaying so many people under the power of God?" In the past, I've hesitated to share what God's shown me over the years regarding this matter, but after much prayer and soul-searching, I understand now that I can no longer in good conscience withhold this vital information so necessary to a thriving ministry of power demonstration.

The systemic law of the Spirit that I'm about to share with you is something God has shown me over the course of years of trial and error. I call this system "The Domino Slay-Line Effect." The first time I really took this question of hit-and-miss slay-line successes to the Lord, He directed me to First Timothy 5:22 which tells us to "Lay hands suddenly on no man..." That's a mistake that many ministers make when they're first starting out in ministry.

Too many are too hasty to lay hands instead of priming the

pump of the Spirit. There's a faith preparation that must go into our work with folks. We've got to build it up or edify it in their minds what they're about to have an experience in God. There's got to be an air of expectation in their midst. Upbeat praise songs and audience enthusiasm and participation are, of course, essential. The air itself should be electrified with faith-excitement. But there's also the very word-age and tone of the minister.



Without the proper preparation that evokes expectancy through faith insinuation and spirit-man intimations, your ministry will fall flat.

I've found that there's an optimum time to lay hands on somebody. It's what I call the "Holy-Ghost Adrenalin Spike." There are several signs to look for that'll tell you, *Yep, they're ready; now's the time to lay hands.* This time is crucial especially at the very start of the slay-line portion of a service. Without observing and waiting for these signs you'll be bound to fail.

When the Holy-Ghost Adrenalin Spike is at its optimum, you will see at least one of the following four slay signs if not more: 1) googly eye-contact (not really focusing on anything), in other words, "seeing they may see, and not perceive" (Mk 4:12), 2) eyes clamped very tight with swaying according to Isaiah 29:9-10:

they are drunken, but not with wine; they stagger, but not with strong drink. For the LORD hath poured out upon you the spirit of deep sleep, and hath closed your eyes...

3) trembling or quivering, based on Habakkuk 3:16: "my belly trembled; my lips quivered ...and I trembled in myself..." and 4) crying, whether weeping or shouting as indicated in Ezekiel 26:15: "Shall not the isles shake at the sound of thy fall, when

the wounded cry..." If you want to see the aisles of your church filled with folks slain under the power of God, Brother, you need to wait till you see at least one of these slay signs on two or three believers.

Once you see two or three believers with at least one of these signs upon them, it's time to lay hands, but don't just lay hands, Brother. You need to come at that Devil with the shout of authority!!! Rush at it! Let your hand dart out to meet the forehead of one of those expectant googly-eyed, swaying, trembling, or crying believers. And when it makes

contact give it a little nudge—not too strong! A true spiritual falling-out under the power of God always starts in the flesh, but ends in the Spirit. Remember that! That little nudge of the flesh should never be enough to push the believer over, but it should give enough impetus for the Holy Ghost to complete the action by fully slaying the believer under the power. Hallelujah!

Once that first one goes down, you need to rush to one of the other believers who's got a slay sign on her and repeat the hand-laying action I just described. With each one that goes down, you're building up Holy-Ghost momentum that'll eventually drive your slay-line like an engine.

You see, my Beloved, there comes a point, usually after about seven (the number of perfection) have fallen, that the slay line takes on a life of its own under the

power of the Holy Ghost. At that point, you don't need to nudge their forehead anymore. In fact you don't even need to make contact with their forehead at all.

At that point, the expectancy is so high among the people that around 70% of them have enough faith to fall. That's when the “Domino Slay-Line Effect” kicks in. Each time they see someone fall their faith levels rise that much more to be knocked under the power themselves.

With such a high faith level, it don't take much at all for them to go down. I just wave my hand and they keel backwards. I swipe them with my suit-jacket and they take the plunge. I blow on them and they fall. I cry “Timber!” and they tip over. I raise my voice a notch and they collapse. I point my finger at them and say, “Bang,” and they drop “dead.” Isn't it wonderful to work with the Holy Ghost!

I could write a book on my experiences with slayment under the power. I've come to expect certain results based on my delivery and I believe every man of God can expect these same results if he'll function under the anointing the way I do. One last note, I recommend always utilizing physically-fit, young men as catchers to back up the slay-line. I'm aware of more than one situation in which the Enemy has been known to take advantage of certain situations where there have not been good catchers present. □
