

The Satanic Verses of Scripture



When the Word of God is found on the lips of Satan or one of His minions is it still to be considered the Word of God or does it become the Word of Satan? Indeed, Satan clearly quotes the Word of God right there in the Word of God. Satan's quoting of the Word occurs when He is tempting Jesus in Matthew 4 and Luke 4. The Enemy quotes Psalms 91:11 and 12, assuring him of the promises of God and encouraging him to step out in faith on the Word of God: "He shall give his angels charge concerning thee: and in their hands they shall bear thee up, lest at any time thou dash thy foot against a stone." But Jesus didn't obey the voice of the Enemy. He didn't cast himself down from the pinnacle of the temple.

Why didn't Jesus follow the behest of the Word found on the lips of Satan? He didn't follow it because he obviously didn't consider it the Word of God when found on the lips of the Devil. Satan is a liar and when He quotes the Word, the Word becomes a lie in His mouth. So just because someone is quoting the Word of God doesn't mean that it is the Word of God. Whether or not something is the Word of God depends on the context. If the context is the twisted, serpentine writhings of Satanic perversity, then a word for word quote of the Word is not the Word of God, but rather the Word of the Serpent. Amen.

Not only does Satan quote the Word in the pages of the Word, but Satan also has inserted His own Word in the pages of the Word. He does this overtly in Genesis chapter three in the words of the Serpent as He speaks to Eve, tempting her to partake of the forbidden fruit. He says, "Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?" Then He says, "Ye shall not surely die: For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil." Notice that first Satan questions the Word of God. Then He flat out contradicts it and, finally, makes a false promise and a suggestion of sedition against the Most High.

Satan also inserts His own Word in the book of Job, chapters 1 and 2. He comes into the very presence of the Most High and admits that He's been roaming the earth to and fro and walking up and down in it (1:7). Then, just as He tempted Eve, the Adversary tempts Papa Jehovah by questioning Job's integrity. He says to Papa God,

Doth Job fear God for nought?
Has not thou made an hedge
about him, and about his house,
and about all that he hath on
every side? thou hast blessed
the work of his hands, and his
substance is increased in the
land. But put forth thine hand
now, and touch all that he hath,
and he will curse thee to thy face.

First Satan questions the integrity of a man of God, then He tempts Papa God to turn on the man, claiming that the man

will end up rebelling against Papa God because he's only serving God to get his needs met." Do you see how the Accuser operates?

Jesus responded to this onslaught of the Enemy in the same way we must respond to the Satanic verses of Scripture.

The Enemy does the same thing in Job 2:4 and 5. He says to Papa God:

Skin for skin, yea, all that a man hath will he give for his life. But put forth thine hand now, and touch his bone and his flesh, and he will curse thee to thy face.

Do you see how Satan has inserted His Word right into the Word of God? He speaks again on the lips of the chief apostle, Peter, in Matthew chapter 16, just six verses after Peter confesses the revelation he'd received from Papa God. In verse 22, Peter or, rather, Satan through Peter, grabs Jesus and begins to rebuke him for predicting that he would be crucified, saying, "Be it far from thee, Lord: this shall not be unto thee." But Jesus responded to this onslaught of the Enemy in the same way we must respond to the Satanic verses of Scripture. Jesus said unto Peter, "Get thee behind me, Satan!" Jesus knew Who he was dealing with. He knew his Enemy and we must know ours. And we must rebuke Him in the name of Jesus.

Do you see how Satan has spoken clearly several times through the very Word of God? How are we to treat such passages? When the very Word of the Devil is found on the pages of Holy Writ, are we to consider it to be the Word of Satan or the Word of God? I believe we must respond the way Jesus responded to the Devil's quoting of Scripture, when he said to the Devil, "Get thee hence, Satan!" (Matt 4:10) and the way Jesus responded to the Devil speaking through Peter, when he said, "Get thee behind me, Satan!" We need to rebuke Him for his intrusions into the Word of God. The Enemy has invaded the sacrosanct pages of the Word of God and we must rebuke Him for it. Amen!

We've seen all the passages where it is blatantly stated that Satan is speaking, but there are other passages where Satan has invaded the revelation of God with His lies just as He hijacked the lips of the chief apostle immediately after he spoke a Word of Knowledge about the true identity of Jesus. How can we know when God is speaking and when Satan is speaking in the pages of the Holy Bible, God's Holy Word? My Beloved, it's gonna take the discernment of the Holy Ghost to know the difference. God's left it up to the believer to tap into Holy-Ghost discernment to distinguish between the Word of God and the Word of Satan in Holy Writ.

You've gotta be prayed up when you approach the Word, otherwise what you may be receiving is the Word of Satan rather than the Word of God. We know that Satan uses the Word and he might talk to you through the Word just as He did to Jesus. We also know that Satan Himself

spoke at times right in the pages of the Word, sometimes clearly identified as Satan and other times coming as a wolf in sheep's clothing, cloaked in the guise of the Word of God. Jesus said, "My sheep hear my voice and they follow me..." (Jn 10:27). And John, one of the Apostles said, "he that is of God heareth us" and Jesus said that if someone neglects "to hear the church, let him be unto thee as an heathen man and a publican" (Matt 18:17).

I would like to focus your attention, my Beloved, on a few of the passages of Holy Writ where Satan, the Serpent, has injected his venomous thoughts in conflict with the rest of the Word of God and the teachings of the Holy Ghost as revealed and practiced within every Holy-Ghost-led church of the Master. As you read my evaluations of the following passages you will learn some of the earmarks of the Word of Satan in Holy Scripture. These vile, Satanic verses are soaked in the venom of the Serpent and as you sensitize your spirit-man to this hellish poison, you will be able to discern a Word of Satan when you happen upon it in the Word of God.

The Enemy has invaded the sacrosanct pages of the Word of God and we must rebuke Him for it.

If you're not prayed up, I suggest you do so before continuing on in the reading of this article because the things I'm about to share with you can rattle the faith of those who are unsettled in their spirit-man.

You're gonna need the shield of faith, Partner, as we launch out into the depths of God's Word and encounter Leviathan right smack dab in the middle of the Ocean of God's precious Word. So grab your Faith-Shield and rap your hand around the hilt of the Rhema-Sword of the Spirit and let's get ready to do battle against strongholds of Satanic piracy out on the high seas of God's Word.

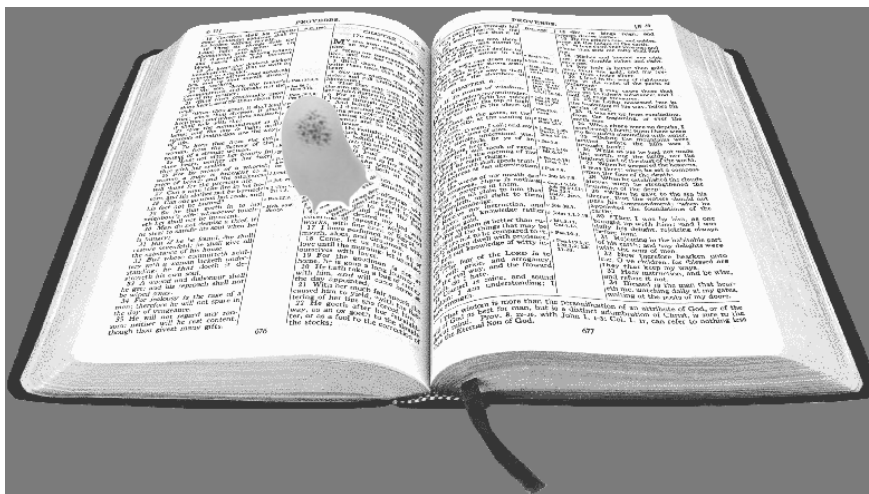
as you sensitize your spirit-man to this hellish poison, you will be able to discern a Word of Satan when you happen upon it in the Word of God.

I don't know how many times I've had baby Christians come to me, telling me they were having doubts as they were giving heed to the lies of Satan and questioning their salvation. One spiritual babe came to me with a verse supporting his questioning of his salvation. He found it in Second Corinthians 13, verse 5: "Examine yourselves, whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own selves, how that Jesus Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates?" I remember the lightning charge of Holy-Ghost power that shot through me when I laid eyes on that verse and knew instantly where it had come from. I'll never forget the look of astonishment in his eyes when I screamed at the Devil, "Get thee behind me, Satan!" His shock subsided, though, as I began to re-walk him through *The Romans Road* and show him how his salvation was assured, based on the Word, and pointing out to him the blatant conflict between

Second Corinthians 13:5 and the rest of Scripture. He thanked me and went on his way rejoicing in Jesus. Amen and amen.

You see, the Word of Satan brings fear and bondage. But the Word of God brings joy and freedom. Hallelujah! One of the most obvious and heinous lies of the Enemy that I've ever seen sticking out of the pages of Scripture like a sore thumb is the one which occurs in Colossians 1:24: "Who now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up that which is behind of the afflictions of Christ in my flesh for his body's sake, which is the church." The *New American Standard Version* says it even clearer: "Now I rejoice in my sufferings for your sake, and in my flesh I do my share on behalf of His body, which is the church, in filling up what is lacking in Christ's afflictions." Do you see how blatant the Enemy is in belittling the afflictions of Christ by saying that they are lacking? What could be lacking when the price has been paid in full? Do you see how this passage doesn't line up with the rest of Scripture and, in fact, contradicts it? Do you see, Neighbor, how obvious it is that this verse is the Word of Satan and not the Word of God? Jesus help us!

Satan will do anything He can to make you question your salvation. He has inserted verses throughout Scripture trying to get believers to doubt that they're really saved and try to get them to trust in their works rather than in the full price that was paid through the afflictions of Christ at Calvary. He injected his venom deep into the book of James and the most evident symptom of it is found in James 2:24-25:



Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only. Likewise also was not Rahab the harlot justified by works, when she had received the messengers, and had sent them out another way?

Notice that this passage never says Rahab repented of her whoredom. This passage just says that her sending the messengers out by another way was what justified her. And to top it off, the passage says that faith alone is insufficient for justification when Paul, writing under the inspiration of the Holy Ghost, says in Romans 3:28 that we're justified by faith apart from works. The message of works righteousness is the message of the Word of Satan and not of God and its turning of a blind eye toward harlotry is right in line with the Great Whore of Babylon prophesied in the Book of Revelations.

The message of works righteousness is found in various pockets within the Word of God as the infection of the Serpent has spread. It's found in the Gospel of Luke, chapter 13, verses 23 and 24, when Jesus is depicted as teaching salvation through the exertion of human labor: "Then said one unto him, Lord, are there few that be

saved? And he said unto them, Strive to enter in at the strait gate: for many, I say unto you, will seek to enter in, and shall not be able." That word "strive" is a clear indicator of the Word of Satan. The infection oozes forth again in Romans 2:9-11:

Tribulation and anguish, upon every soul of man that doeth evil, of the Jew first, and also of the Gentile; But glory, honour, and peace, to every man that worketh good, to the Jew first, and also to the Gentile: For there is no respect of persons with God.

But this can't be true because the Word says, "There is none righteous, no, not one" (Rom 3:10).

We see this works-righteousness poison once again in Acts 10:4 when an angel supposedly says to the unsaved Gentile Cornelius, "Thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a memorial before God." It resurfaces in verses 34 and 35 in the words of the chief apostle as he preaches to the unsaved Gentile Cornelius and his household: "Of a truth I perceive that God is no respecter of persons: But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him." Can you see, my Beloved,

how the Serpent has infected the Word of God with His lies of righteousness through works?

The Word of Satan teaches that folks can actually do something to deliver themselves from their sins. We see this poisonous message in the pseudo-Scripture-verse Daniel 4:27 where Daniel is pictured as counseling King Nebuchadnezzar, saying, "Break off thy sins by righteousness, and thine iniquities by shewing mercy to the poor." Here Satan's Word claims that a person can break off his sins by works-righteousness and giving money to the poor. Get thee behind me, Satan! I rebuke you in the name of Jesus!

We see a similar statement being made in Acts 2:40 where the chief apostle once again becomes the mouthpiece of Satan, saying, "Save yourselves from this untoward generation," thus misleading folks toward the flames of perdition by deceiving them into believing that they can do anything to save themselves. We also find a similar message on the lips of Ananias in Acts 22:16 where he supposedly tells Paul to "be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord" (Acts 22:16). There are several perversions of the Enemy taking place in this verse. Here Satan makes it appear as if Paul was getting baptized before he had his sins washed away, but we know that the Word teaches that only those who are already saved and had their sins washed away in the blood of Jesus can legitimately be baptized. Furthermore, the Enemy is saying here that it is possible for a person to wash his own sins away rather than God doing the washing. Can you see

here the Word of Satan in operation, my Beloved?

Satan does it again in First Peter 3:21 where he says very clearly that "baptism doth also now save us" (I Peter 3:21). Beloved, it is God that saves, not baptism. Satan is a liar! Rebuke Him, my Beloved, in the name of Jesus!

In Luke 1:15, the Enemy injects the lie that a baby could actually be filled with the Holy Ghost, not to mention saved! We find this lie supposedly on the lips of the angel Gabriel, when he is depicted as telling Zecharias that John the Baptist "shall be filled with the Holy Ghost, even from his mother's womb." Nevertheless, we know that a baby isn't conscious enough to receive the mighty infilling of the Holy Ghost. A baby doesn't have the faith to receive it. Furthermore, babies are not able to talk in tongues and prophesy. Do you see how Satan injected this venomous lie into the pages of Holy Writ in order to deceive the second-century church into the Catholic heresy of infant baptism?

Not only did the Enemy sow the seeds of infant baptism in Scripture, He also sowed the seeds of extra-biblical tradition by injecting His Word into Paul's second letter to the Thessalonians, chapter 2, verse 15, where it says, "Brethren, stand fast, and hold the

traditions which ye have been taught, whether by word, or our epistle." Do you see how that opens the door for things that aren't mentioned in the Word? It opens Pandora's Box of Catholic tradition and the doctrines of men, making the Word of God of none effect. Satan always wants to incite a rebellion against the Word of God, especially among folks who call themselves Christians. He'll use every means within his arsenal to sabotage the Word of God.

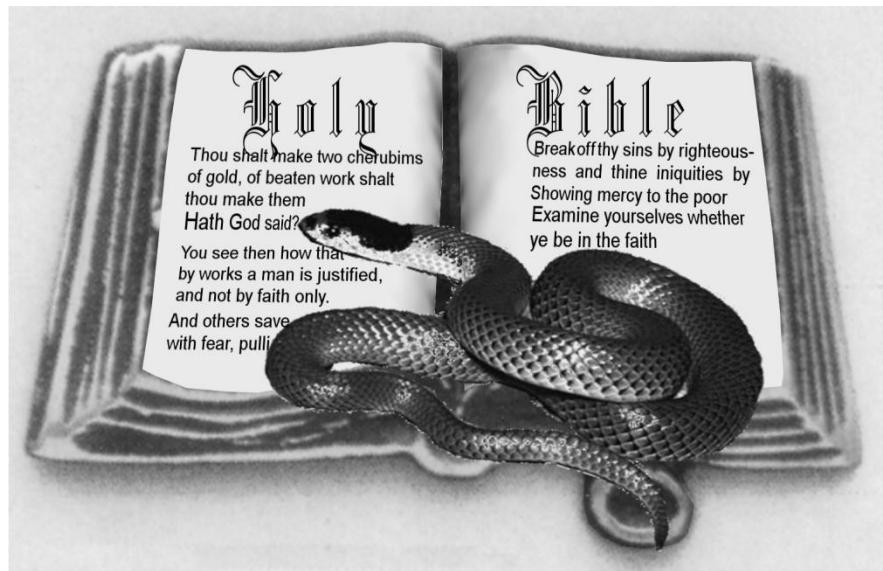
We see Satan sowing the seeds for the Catholic error of the Physical Presence of Christ in communion in First Corinthians 10:16 where Paul is supposedly writing, "The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?" The *New International Version* makes the Greek of Satan's Word even more clear: "Is not the cup of thanksgiving for which we give thanks a participation in the blood of Christ? And is not the bread that we break a participation in the body of Christ?" Now, my Beloved, what Satan is suggesting here is that communion is an actual partaking of the body and blood of Christ. Do you see how Satan seeded the Scriptures with the germs of Catholic abomination? Oh what a Deceiver!

Another thing the Enemy did was sow two different Scriptures which when taken together result in the conclusion that we're still waiting to be justified by faith. Satan puts it in the future rather than acknowledging that righteousness by faith is a present possession of the saints. Listen

to these words from the Serpent: “For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith” (Gal 5:5). Notice what it says here. It perpetrates that lie that we are still waiting for the hope of righteousness by faith, putting it in the future rather than in the present. Then Satan bolsters His Word in Galatians with another of His words in Romans: “For we are saved by hope: but hope that is seen is not hope: for what a man seeth, why doth he yet hope for? But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it” (Rom 8:24-25). Notice the lie of the Enemy that “we are saved by hope” rather than “by faith” as the Word of God clearly states. Hope never saved anybody, my Beloved, and Satan knows that. He wants to detract people from the only means of salvation which is *faith*.

So we see how Satan can sow the seeds of some hellish doctrine in various places in Scripture, knowing that these seeds would someday be brought together by men of perverse minds for the creation of some damnable heresy unto the perdition of lost souls. He sowed other seeds in the Bible to try to undermine the divinity of Jesus Christ. In First Timothy 6:16, His injected Word says that no man can see God while the Word of God states clearly that the Word was God (Jn 1:1) and we have looked upon the Word of life (I Jn 1:1). Now that’s a flat contradiction. Do you see how Satan’s Word and God’s Word are always in conflict?

Another such contradiction is found in Exodus and it is there that we also find the seeds of Catholic abomination. The Ten Commandments state very clearly in Exodus 20:4, “Thou



shalt not make unto thee any graven image, or any likeness of any thing that is in heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth.” Then, just five chapters later, in Exodus 25:18, we find a clear injection of the venomous Word of Satan: “And thou shalt make two cherubims of gold, of beaten work shalt thou make them, in the two ends of the mercy seat” (Exod 25:18). You see how Satan would claim that there were graven images on the most holy object used in Israel’s worship? Now tell me that isn’t a lie of the Enemy inserted to deceive the people of God into the error of Catholic adoration of ceramic, wood, metal, and plastic idols? That’s just like Satan! Satan was an anointed cherub before he fell and now he wanted to receive the worship of Israel by being enthroned upon the ark of the covenant!

It’s just like Satan to tamper with the holiest things of God. The Word of Lucifer would make the ark of the covenant an object of worship. Take a look at these Satanic verses from First Chronicles chapter 16:

And he appointed certain of the Levites to minister before the ark of the LORD, and to record, and to thank and praise the LORD God of Israel... So he left there before the ark of the covenant of the LORD Asaph and his brethren, to minister before the ark continually, as every day’s work required (I Chron 16:4, 37).

Now you might think this is a benign verse of Scripture, untouched by the lies of the Enemy, but its innocence is just a ploy of the Devil who comes as an Angel of Light. You see, this verse is just a set-up for other verses which condone an all-out worship of the ark of the covenant. Satan has His verses which harmonize together to create the various component doctrines of the Great Whore—that Jezebelian companion of the Beast. I’ll try not to get sidetracked into Bible prophecy. The Lord knows how much I relish digging into Revelations.

The most blatant Satanic verses propagating the Catholic heresy of object veneration are seen in Joshua, First Kings, and Second Samuel: “And Joshua rent his clothes, and fell to the earth

upon his face before the ark of the LORD until the eventide, he and the elders of Israel" (Josh 7:6). "And [Solomon] came to Jerusalem, and stood before the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and offered up burnt offerings, and offered peace offerings" (I Kings 3:15). "And David was afraid of the LORD that day, and said, How shall the ark of the LORD come to me?" (II Sam 6:9). When I read over these Satanic verses, I can see the lost souls of millions of Catholics bowing before statues of Jesus and Mary, offering their bread and wine offerings before crucifixes and actually fearing the physical objects of their traditionalistic religiosity. And they think they're following the Word of God. They've failed to rightly divide the Word (I Tim 2:15) and distinguish the Word of Satan from the Word of God.

The purported words of David, "How shall the ark of the LORD come to me," remind me of another Satanic passage found in Luke 1:41-43:

And it came to pass, that, when Elisabeth heard the salutation of Mary, the babe leaped in her womb; and Elisabeth was filled with the Holy Ghost: And she spake out with a loud voice, and said, Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb. And whence is this to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?

Do you hear the echo of David's words regarding the ark of the Lord coming to him in the words of Elizabeth regarding the "mother of my Lord" coming to her? You see how the same Devil that instigates object worship also propagates the worship of Mary, even attributing this idolatrous act to the filling of the Holy Ghost? Blasphemy! Are we

to believe that someone filled with the Holy Ghost would bless and venerate anybody other than God? Only Satan would put Mary in there as an object of Elizabeth's Holy-Ghost-inspired blessing. Get thee behind me, Satan!

...that is simply a lie of Satan to lead us into the error of Catholicism so that we will join the ranks of the Great, End-Time Whore.

We also find the seeds of the Catholic error of praying to the saints sown by Satan in Acts chapter 16, verse 9: "And a vision appeared to Paul in the night; There stood a man of Macedonia, and prayed him, saying, Come over into Macedonia, and help us." Then Satan sowed another seed of this error in Jude 23: "And others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh." The Word of Satan is implying here that one human being can save another. But, my Beloved, I'll have you know, based on the Word of God, not the Word of Satan, that only God can save. A human being cannot save anyone. Jude 23 is tainted with the lying, forked tongue of the Serpent.

Sometimes Satan will co-opt a legitimate Word of God such as Hebrews 12, verses 1 and 23, which states that believers are in the company of the spirits of just men made perfect and are surrounded by a great cloud of witnesses. He takes these verses and twists them by combining them with the seeds of His lies in

Acts 16:9 and Jude 23, implying that such spirits could be entreated to pray for believers on earth. But that is simply a lie of Satan to lead us into the error of Catholicism so that we will join the ranks of the Great, End-Time Whore.

I remember one time back in the early 70's when the Catholic charismatic move of God was shaking up the traditionalism of the Catholic church as God was saving Catholics and baptizing them with the Holy Ghost and fire with the evidence of speaking in other tongues. This newly saved Catholic brother came to me during one of my prophecy crusades out in Tampa and showed me Second Kings 13:21:

And it came to pass, as they were burying a man, that, behold, they spied a band of men; and they cast the man into the sepulchre of Elisha: and when the man was let down, and touched the bones of Elisha, he revived, and stood up on his feet.

He was all excited about it because he thought he'd found biblical proof for the Catholic teaching that God works miracles through the relics of dead saints. I staunchly rebuked him in the name of Jesus and then I told the Devil to get out of Dodge! I saw the error of the verse immediately and knew in my spirit that it was one of the Satanic verses of Scripture.

How did I know that Second Kings 13:21 was a Satanic verse of Scripture? Because there wasn't just one dead man in this story: there were two. Elisha was just as dead as the other dead man they were burying. Old, dead Elisha couldn't perform a miracle and Papa God doesn't work through dead men.

O Hallelujah! He works through people who are living, breathing temples of the Holy Ghost, not dead men's bones within the whitewashed sepulchres of Roman Catholicism (Matt 23:27). I also knew that according to Hebrews 9:27, "It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment." Based on that verse, it didn't make sense that a man who was already dead would be raised from the dead only to die again. I was bound to question this verse shown to me by that Catholic brother and recognize it as the Word of Satan. I shared my revelations with that dear brother and was able to bring him into a greater revelation of the Word of God that helped him leave the tomb of Roman Catholicism and live in the glory of God's Full Gospel revelation.

When you can interpret the Word in another way, it is always best to assume that it is the Word of God, rather than the Word of Satan.

Some of the brethren claim that Second Peter 1:15 is a Satanic verse, but I'm inclined to disagree. In this verse, the Apostle Peter states, "Moreover I will endeavour that ye may be able after my decease to have these things always in remembrance." Some claim that Satan is saying here that Peter was claiming that after he had ceased from his labors and gone home to glory he would endeavor to remind the church of his instruction, thus boosting

the Catholic heresy of the intercession of the saints. But I believe that Peter was saying that he was writing this epistle in order to leave behind a legacy that would remind the believers of his teaching. That interpretation seems more likely. When you can interpret the Word in another way, it is always best to assume that it is the Word of God, rather than the Word of Satan.

A much more obvious Satanic verse occurs in First Samuel 28, the account of King Saul's visit to the necromancer of Endor to try to contact the dead Prophet Samuel through her mediumship. Now I'm not saying that this whole account is the Word of Satan, but what I am saying is a certain portion of it is Satanic. In verse 14, the witch says she sees an old man coming up out of the earth, covered with a mantle. Then Satan injects this portion of the verse, "And Saul perceived that it was Samuel, and he stooped with his face to the ground, and bowed himself." There are two problems with this. First of all, the dead spirit of Samuel would not be appearing through the spiritist medium. The old man seen by the witch is a demon spirit masquerading as the Prophet Samuel. Secondly, if that spirit really had been the Prophet Samuel, it would have forbidden Saul to bow to him since we are only to bow to God, not to a saint or spirit of a prophet of God. King Saul was involved in the sin of necromancy and was bowing to a demon spirit.

Do you see how Satan wants to involve you in the sin of necromancy? Necromancy is communicating with the dead. It's what Catholics do when they pray to saints. They are

attempting to communicate with the dead. In order to infect early Christians with the sin of necromancy and prayer to "the saints" which are really demon spirits as we see in their manifestations in the voodoo religion, the Devil injected his venom into the account of the Transfiguration of Christ. The Word of Satan says, "And there appeared unto them Elias with Moses: and they were talking with Jesus" (Mk 9:4). How do I know that this verse is the Word of Satan and not the Word of God? Because Moses was dead and if Jesus was speaking with him, that would make Jesus a necromancer just as much as any Roman Catholic. Far be it from Jesus to involve himself in demonism.

Satan sowed the seeds of the Catholic and Eastern Orthodox ritual of praying for the dead in the Book of First Peter which claims that Jesus went by the Spirit "and preached unto the spirits in prison" (I Pet 3:19). Then nine verses later, the Word of Satan says that the gospel was "preached also to them that are dead, that they might be judged according to men in the flesh, but live according to God in the spirit" (I Pet 4:6). Do you see how these Satanic verses deceive the minds and hearts of men into thinking that they will have a second chance after they die? But the Word of God is clear. "It is appointed unto men once to

die, but after this the judgment.” Satan even provides an example of prayer for the dead in Second Timothy 1:16-18.

The Lord give mercy unto the house of Onesiphorus; for he oft refreshed me, and was not ashamed of my chain... The Lord grant unto him that he may find mercy of the Lord in that day...

Why would Paul pray for Onesiphorus, if Onesiphorus was already saved? And if he wasn't saved, why would the Lord grant him mercy on the Last Day if he wasn't saved? Do you feel confused? You know who the Author of Confusion is? It isn't God! Satan furthermore omits Onesiphorus from Paul's salutation in II Timothy 4:19: "Salute Prisca and Aquila and the household of Onesiphorus." The Enemy does this in order to mislead us into thinking that Paul was not saluting Onesiphorus because he was already dead and Paul was praying for the dead in chapter 1, verse 18, in order to provide a pseudo-scriptural basis for the Satanic lie of praying for the dead.

Satan would also have us believe that Elisha the Prophet condoned idolatry or, at the very least, saw no need to forbid it. The Satanic Verses claim that Naaman the Syrian asked Papa God to be forgiving of him whenever he would go into the temple of the pagan god Rimmon and bow himself in the temple of Rimmon when his master leaned upon his hand. Then the Word of Satan says that Elisha replied, "Go in peace" (II Kings 5:18-19).

Satan also claims in Acts 17:23 that even the unsaved can worship God in ignorance, but we know from the Word of God that Papa God seeks the true

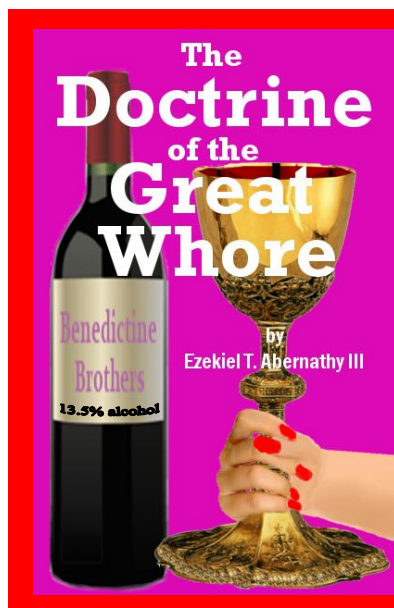

Always approach the Word with great care, taking the whole armor of God and being prayed up in the Holy Ghost. Otherwise, you can easily be led astray and lost for all eternity in the unending nightmare of a Devil's Hell. ☒
